



MAKE A SPINNING WAND FROM REPURPOSED MATERIALS

Magic Wands ScrapsKC

Take a look at your materials! The metal rod is a repurposed knitting needle and the plastic rings were cut from washed pill bottles. The metal tube was also cut from knitting needles! Notice that the plastic pill bottle rings have two holes, one drilled on the top and one on the bottom. You will be stacking your rings and beads in whichever order you choose and securing them in place with the small rubber gaskets.



Start with your knitting needle rod. The glued bead is the top of the wand. Lay out the order of your design. Add your gaskets throughout. Start with another bead or gasket to the top, or start with a pill bottle ring. Insert the rod through the top hole of a plastic ring and add more beads, or the smaller ring and metal tube, before running the rod through the bottom hole of the rings. Add more beads at the bottom if you want! When the wand is how you like it, slide one small rubber gasket as the last piece to secure the other pieces in place.

The rings should be loose enough to spin!
